RULES:

Entry into the Comanche County Spring Show, exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules set forth and decisions by the Comanche Co Show Committee. All show day announcements take precedence over previous announcements.



- This show is open to any bonafide 4-H or FFA member.
- Age divisions (age on Jan. 1st, current year): Senior 14-18, Intermediate 10-13, Junior 7-9, PeeWee 6 and under.
- All animals must be shown by the owner listed on the entry form, unless they have more than one animal per class. Exhibitors MUST show their own animal in Showmanship.
- Exhibitor may enter as many exhibits as he/she wishes and must own them.
- NO PAY NO WEIGH NO REFUNDS
- Animals subject to weigh back. <u>EVERY ANIMAL NEEDS A WEIGH</u> <u>CARD, breeding animals don't need a declared weight but DO need</u> <u>a card.</u>
- If animals are not checked in, they will NOT show.
- All animals will be shown as prospects, not finished animals.
- This show is "Blow & SHOW". Paint, glue and adhesives will NOT be allowed.
- Show committee shall, upon completion of the official weigh-in, determine classes for the event.
- All animals \$15 per head Pre Entries due Monday, April 16th. <u>Make</u> <u>checks payable to Comanche County 4-H Council.</u>
- **All entries are accepted in the understanding that the Comanche County Spring Show Committee, The Comanche County Extension Council, and/or the Comanche County Fair Board are not responsible for any loss or damage that may arise.**
- There will be no alcoholic beverages allowed on the 4-H grounds.



No bedding is provided. Showing out of your trailers is encouraged – pen space is limited. <u>NO BEDDING in</u> barns.

 All small animals must be born on or after January 1st of the current year.

- All breeding heifers and their registrations papers will be brought to the beef weigh-in station and checked in. All tattoos and registration papers must match. If a match cannot be made, the heifer will only be allowed to show in the commercial class, NO exceptions.
- Exhibitors are expected to respect and meet Kansas Animal Health Requirements. Please consult your local Veterinarian.
- No intact males, except for bucket calves.
- All Lambs/goats must be free of club lamb fungus and sore mouth, or the show committee will dismiss the lamb.
- No unnecessary rough handling of animals will be allowed.
- Comanche County Spring Show committee reserves the right, to remove from the grounds any exhibitor, animal or person that may be deemed objectionable.
- Barns will be open for any exhibitors who wish to bring animals in the night before. Arrangements must be made through the show committee. <u>All pens and area occupied during the day of the show</u> <u>must be cleaned by the exhibitor. Animals are to remain in their</u> <u>pens or on grassy areas ONLY.</u>
- The show committee reserves the right to decide on any questions that are not listed in the rules.
- The decision of the judge is FINAL.
- Protests or grievances of any kind must be submitted in writing, signed and accompanied by a \$200 fee.
- Anyone passing an insufficient funds check will be required to pay cash for the current year.
